Your Programme

Weeks 1 & 2 – Indian Business Dynamics & Opportunities

In the first two weeks of this unique four week program, you will be focusing on the business dynamics of India and participating in various lectures and field visits. Studying alongside local students in a quality business college, you'll learn the historic similarities that link the UK and India, and the everyday differences that need to be considered when doing business with this emerging economic powerhouse.

Week 3 – Social Enterprise Initiative

The challenges posed by public health, education and care in India are enormous. In order to better appreciate the way these challenges are faced, you will be placed in a Social Service Organisation, receive a short lecture on the health scenario in the country and learn about the public health services available. You will meet with a senior person working in the field of public health and sanitation, and also have the opportunity to experience directly the challenges and rewards offered by social enterprise through participation in a voluntary assignment. You will be given the chance to visit a school for the visually-challenged, a drop-in centre for street children and a women and children's home.



Week 4 – Cultural Tour

By your final week, you'll have gained some understanding of and familiarity with the diverse cultures of India. You'll now travel to some important cultural sites, seeing them through the eyes of an insider, rather than a tourist. Besides local visits in and around Delhi, you'll take a trip to Agra to see the famous Taj Mahal, visit Jaipur in the desert lands and tour the holy cities of Haridwar and Rishikesh, on the River Ganges, visiting various temples and monuments. In Rishikesh you'll spend three nights in an 'Ashram' - a Hindu Hermitage - absorbing the tranquillity and reflecting on the depth of your experiences over the last weeks.
